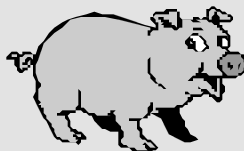

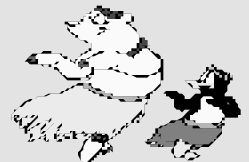

All of the proposed changes to the General Laws were passed by the attending delegate members at the International Convention in Las Vegas. There are two changes that will affect you as a member directly. These are the cross sponsorship of new or re-enrolled members and the definition of qualified guests. The Cross Sponsorship allows you to sponsor a member in either the Loyal Order of Moose or the Women of the Moose. You will receive full sponsor credit and this change goes into effect on August 1<sup>st</sup>. The term "Qualified Guest" has been re-defined and is basically defined as any non-member who is 21 years of age and not your spouse. They are allowed only two visits to the lodge. The third visit should include an application for membership. The entire "Proposed Changes to the General Laws" is posted on our website,

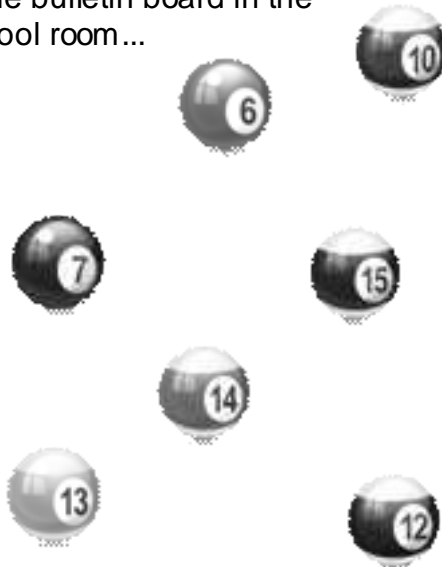
## Fast Eddie's Table Chatter
